~ After the Great Litany ~

The First Antiphon

Shout with joy to God, all the earth. Sing to His name; give glory to His praises.

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

Say to God: "How awesome are Thy works!" Let all the earth worship Thee, and sing to Thee. Let it sing a song to Thy Name, O Most High. (*Refrain*)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen. (*Refrain*)

Apolytikion of Pascha (Tone Five - SLOW PACE)

Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death, and to those in the tombs, bestowing life. الْمَسِيحُ قَامَ مِنْ بَيْنِ الْأَمْوَاتِ، وَوَطِئَ الْمَوْتَ بِالْمَوْتِ، وَوَهَبَ الْحَيَاةَ لِلَّذِينَ فِي الْقُبُورِ.

In the gathering places, bless ye God the Lord from the springs of Israel. Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

Resurrectional Apolytikion (Tone Two)

When Thou didst submit Thyself unto death, O Thou deathless and immortal One, then Thou didst destroy hell with Thy Godly power. And when Thou didst raise the dead from beneath the earth, all the powers of Heaven did cry aloud unto Thee: O Christ, Thou giver of life, glory to Thee.

Apolytikion of Joseph of Arimathea (Tone Two)

The noble Joseph, taking Thine immaculate Body down from the Tree, and having wrapped It in pure linen and spices, laid It for burial in a new tomb. But on the third day Thou didst arise, O Lord, granting to the world Great Mercy.

Apolytikion of the Myrrh-Bearing Women (Tone Two)

Unto the myrrh-bearing women did the Angel cry out as he stood by the grave: Myrrh-oils are meet for the dead, but Christ hath proved to be a stranger to corruption. But cry out: The Lord is risen, granting to the world Great Mercy.

Apolytikion of Saint George (Tone Four)

Since thou art a liberator and deliverer of captives, a help and support of the poor and needy, a healing physician of the sick, a contender and fighter for kings, O great among Martyrs, the victory-clad George; intercede with Christ God for the salvation of our souls.

Kontakion of Pascha (Tone Eight)

Though Thou didst descend into the grave, O Immortal One, yet didst Thou destroy the power of Hades, and didst arise as victor, O Christ God, calling to the myrrh-bearing women, Rejoice, and giving peace unto Thine Apostles, O Thou Who dost grant resurrection to the fallen.

The Reading from the Acts of the Apostles (6:1-7).

In those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplying, the Hellenists murmured against the Hebrews because their widows were neglected in the daily ministry. And the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said: "It is not right that we should forsake the word of God to serve tables. Therefore, brethren, pick out from among you seven men of good report, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may appoint to this duty. And we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." And the saying pleased the whole multitude, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Próchoros, and Nikánor, and Tímon, and Parmenás, and Nikólaos a proselyte of Antioch. These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands upon them. And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem exceedingly, and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith."

فِي تِلْكَ الْأَيَّامِ، لَمَّا تَكَثَّرَ التَّلَامِيذُ، حَدَّثَ تَدْمُرٌ مِنَ الْيُونَانِيِّينَ عَلَى الْعِبْرَانِيِّينَ بِأَنَّ أَرَامِلَهُمْ كُنَّ يَهْمَلْنَ فِي الْخِدْمَةِ الْيَوْمِيَّةِ. فَدَعَا الْإِثْنَا عَشَرَ جُمُهورَ التَّلَامِيذِ وَقَالُوا: «لَا يَحْسُنُ أَنْ نَتْرَكَ نَحْنُ كَلِمَةَ اللَّهِ وَنَخْدَمَ الْمَوَائِدَ. فَانْتَخِبُوا أَيُّهَا الْإِخْوَةُ مِنْكُمْ سَبْعَةَ رِجَالٍ، مَشْهُودٍ لَهُمْ بِالْفَضْلِ، مُمْتَلِئِينَ مِنَ الرُّوحِ الْقُدُسِ وَالْحِكْمَةِ، فَتَقِيمُهُمْ عَلَى هَذِهِ الْحَاجَةِ. وَنُؤَاظِبُ نَحْنُ عَلَى الصَّلَاةِ وَخِدْمَةِ الْكَلِمَةِ.» فَحَسَّنَ الْكَلَامَ لَدَى جَمِيعِ الْجُمُهورِ. فَاخْتَارُوا إِسْتِفَانُوسَ، رَجُلًا مُمْتَلئًا مِنَ الْإِيمَانِ وَالرُّوحِ الْقُدُسِ، وَفِيلِيبُسَ وَبَرُوخُورُسَ وَنِيكَانُورَ وَتِيمُونَ وَبَرْمِنَاسَ وَنِيْقُولَاوُسَ دَخِيلاً أَنْطَاكِيًّا. وَأَقَامُوهُمْ أَمَامَ الرُّسُلِ. فَصَلُّوا وَوَضَعُوا عَلَيْهِمُ الْأَيْدِي. وَكَانَتْ كَلِمَةُ اللَّهِ تَنْمُو، وَعَدَدُ التَّلَامِيذِ يَتَكَثَّرُ فِي أُورُشَلِيمَ جِدًّا. وَكَانَ جَمْعٌ كَثِيرٌ مِنَ الْكَهَنَةِ يُطِيعُونَ الْإِيمَانَ.

THE GOSPEL

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Mark. (15:43-16:8)

At that time, Joseph of Arimathaea, a respected member of the council, who was also himself looking for the Kingdom of God, took courage and went to Pilate, and asked for the body of Jesus. And Pilate wondered if He were already dead; and summoning the centurion, he asked him whether Jesus was already dead. And when he learned from the centurion that He was dead, he granted the body to Joseph. And he bought a linen shroud, and taking Him down, wrapped Him in the linen shroud, and laid Him in a tomb, which had been hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a stone against the door of the tomb. Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joseph saw where He was laid. And when the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, bought spices, so that they might go and anoint Jesus. And very early in the morning, on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb at the rising of the sun. And they were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the door of the tomb?" And looking up, they saw that the stone was rolled back – it was very large. And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a long white robe; and they were amazed. And he said to them, "Do not be amazed; you seek Jesus of Nazareth, Who was crucified. He is risen; He is not here; see the place where they laid Him. But go, tell His disciples and Peter that He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see Him, as He told you." And they went out quickly and fled from the tomb; for trembling and astonishment had come upon them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

فصل شريف من بشارة القديس مرقس الإنجيلي البشير والتلميذ الطاهر

في ذلك الزمان، جاء يوسف الذي من الرامة، مشير تقي، وكان هو أيضاً منتظراً ملكوت الله. فاجترأ ودخل على بيلاطس وطلب جسد يسوع. فاستغرب بيلاطس أنه قد مات هكذا سريعاً. واستدعى قائد المئة وسأله هل له زمان قد مات. ولما عرف من القائد، وهب الجسد ليوسف. فاشترى كتاناً، وأنزله، ولفه في الكتان، ووضعته في قبر كان منحوتاً في صخرة، ودحرج حجراً على باب القبر. وكانت مريم المجدلية ومريم أم يوسى تنظران أين وضع. ولما انقضى السبت، اشترت مريم المجدلية ومريم أم يعقوب وسالومة حنوطاً ليأتين ويذهنه. وبكرن جداً في أول الأسبوع وأتىن القبر وقد طلعت الشمس. وكُنَّ يقلن فيما بينهنَّ «من يدحرج لنا الحجر عن باب القبر؟» فتطلعن، فرأين الحجر قد دحرج، لأنه كان عظيمًا جداً. فلما دخلن القبر، رأين شاباً جالساً عن اليمين، لابساً حلة بيضاء، فانذهلن. فقال لهنَّ: «لا تنذهلن. أنتن تطلبن يسوع الناصري المصلوب. قد قام، ليس هو ههنا. هوذا الموضع الذي وضعوه فيه. فاذهبن وقلن لتلاميذه ولبطرس إنه يسبقكم إلى الجليل، هناك ترونه كما قال لكم.» فخرجن سريعاً وفررن من القبر وقد أخذتهن الرعدة والدهش. ولم يقلن لأحد شيئاً لأنهن كن خائفات.

THE SYNAXARION



On May 16, in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the **Venerable Theodore the Sanctified, disciple of Pachomios the Great; Alexander, archbishop of Jerusalem; New-martyr Nicholas of Metsov; and Venerable Ephraim of Perekop, wonderworker of Novgorod.** On this day, the third Sunday of Pascha, we celebrate the feast of the **holy Myrrh-bearing women.** And we also commemorate **Joseph of Arimathaea, the secret disciple, and Nicodemus, the disciple by night.** The women went to Christ's tomb on Holy Pascha to anoint His body, only to discover it empty. We know the

names of only eight of these women: Mary the Theotokos, the “mother” of James and Joses, who were the sons of Joseph the Betrothed from his previous marriage (Matt. 27:56 and Mark 15:40); Mary Magdalene; Mary, the wife of Cleopas; Joanna the wife of Chuza; Salome the mother of the sons of Zebedee; Susanna; and Mary and Martha, the sisters of Lazarus. Joseph was a rich and noble man, and a member of the Privy Council of Jerusalem. He dared to ask Pilate for the undefiled body of our Savior, which he took and buried in his own new tomb. Accompanying Joseph to the sepulcher was Nicodemus, a Jerusalemite who was one of the leaders of the Pharisees. Nicodemus brought 100 pounds of myrrh and aloes to scent and embalm the body of Christ. By the intercessions of the holy Myrrh-bearers, Joseph of Arimathaea and Nicodemus, O God, have mercy on us. Amen.

Megalynarion for Pascha (Tone One)

The Angel cried unto her that is full of grace: O pure Virgin, rejoice, and again I say, rejoice; for thy Son hath arisen from the grave on the third day. Shine, shine, O new Jerusalem, for the glory of the Lord hath arisen upon thee; dance now and be glad, O Zion, and do thou exult, O pure Theotokos, in the arising of Him Whom thou didst bear.

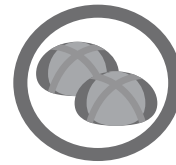

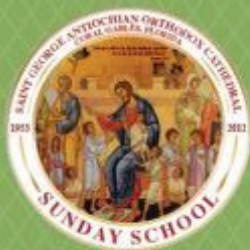

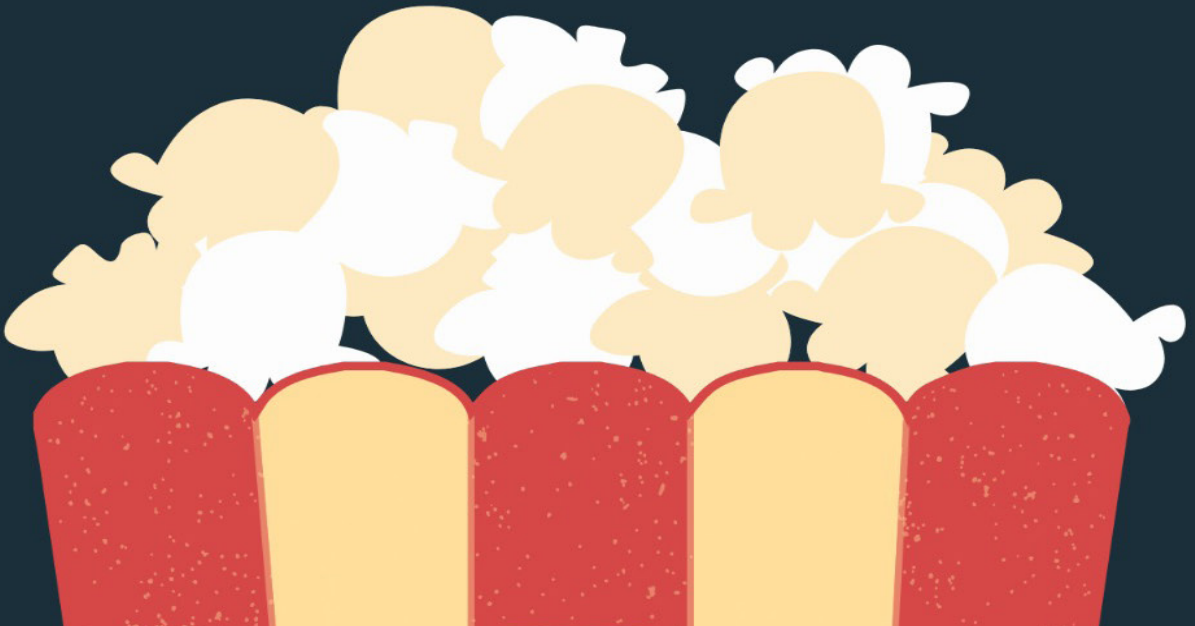
