#### The Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Galatians. (4:22-27).

Brethren, Abraham had two sons, one by the handmaid, and one by the freewoman. But the one from the handmaid is born according to the flesh; whereas the one from the freewoman is through the promise. These things are an allegory, for these women are two covenants. One is from Mount Sinai, bearing children for bondage, which is Hagar. For Sinai, which corresponds to Hagar, is a mountain in Arabia, and resembles the present Jerusalem, for she is in bondage with her children. But the Jerusalem that is above is free, and she is the mother of us all. For it is written, "Rejoice, O barren one who does not bear; break forth and cry out, you who are not in travail: For many are the children of the desolate, much more than of her who has a husband."

#### THE SYNAXARION

On July 25 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the **Dormition of Saint Anna, Mother of the Most Holy Theotokos**.

According to tradition, Anna, the ancestor of God, lived for 79 years, and her spouse Joachim, for 80, who preceded Anna in death. They were married for 50 years and prayed to God for a child—male or female—to comfort them in their old age. Anna gave birth to the one who would bear God in her womb. The Theotokos had been orphaned of both her parents when she was 11 years old, when she was living in the Temple

Saint Anna is invoked for conceiving children, and for help in difficult childbirth.

On this day, we also commemorate our righteous mothers **Olympias the deaconess of Constantinople**; and **Eupraxia of Tabenna**. By the intercessions of Thy Saints, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen




# Great Vespers, Orthros, & Divine Liturgy For The Feast Of The Transfiguration of the Lord

Celebrations for the Great and Holy Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ will take place in the following order:

Thursday August 05: Great Vespers at 4:00 p.m.

Festal Orthros at 5:15 p.m.

Divine Liturgy at 6:30 p.m. (Followed by Blessing of Grapes)





THE DORMITION FAST begins on Sunday, August 1st and ends on Sunday, August 15th, after the Divine Liturgy for the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos. During the Dormition Fast, we encourage all faithful to observe the traditional fasting discipline (no meat, poultry, eggs, dairy, fish) Monday through Sunday. Wine is Only allowed on Saturdays and Sundays. Exceptionally, fish is allowed on Thursday, August 6th, after the Divine Liturgy for the feast of the Transfiguration.

Also, the Paraklesis Service to the Most Holy Theotokos will be served at 6:00 p.m on:

Mondays August 2 & 9
Wednesday August 4 & 11
Friday August 6 & 13




