Troparion of the Resurrection (Tone Three)

Let the heavens rejoice and the earth be glad, for the Lord hath done a mighty act with His own arm; He hath trampled down death by death and became the first-born from the dead; He hath delivered us from the depths of Hades, granting the world the great mercy.

For since they possessed Thy strength, they cast down the tyrants and wholly destroyed the demons' strengthless presumption. O Christ God, by their prayers, save our souls, since Thou art merciful.

الرسالة للأحد العشرين بعد العنصرة Epistle for the Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost

Sing praises to our God, sing praises! Clap your hands, all you nations!

The Reading is from Saint Paul's Letter to the Galatians (1:11-19)

Brethren, I would have you know that the gospel which was preached by me is not man's gospel. For I did not receive it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came through a revelation of Jesus Christ. For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it; and I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers. But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and had called me through his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not confer with flesh and blood, nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia; and again I returned to Damascus. Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas, and remained with him fifteen days. But I saw none of the other apostles except James the Lord's brother.

الإنجيل للأحد السادس من لوقا Gospel of the Sixth Sunday of Saint Luke

The Reading is from the Holy Gospel according to Saint Luke (8:26-39)

At that time, Jesus arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, which is opposite Galilee. And as He stepped out on land, there met Him a man from the city who had demons; for a long time he had worn no clothes, and he lived not in a house but among the tombs. When he saw Jesus, he cried out and fell down before him, and said with a loud voice, "What hast Thou to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beseech Thee, do not torment me." For Jesus had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For many a time it had seized him; he was kept under guard, and bound with chains and fetters, but he broke the bonds and was driven by the demon into the desert. Jesus then asked him, "What is your name?" And he said, "Legion"; for many demons had entered him. And they begged Jesus not to command them to depart into the abyss. Now a large herd of swine was feeding there on the hillside; and they begged Jesus to let them enter these. So He gave them leave. Then the demons came out of the man and entered the swine, and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the lake and was drowned. When the herdsmen saw what had happened, they fled, and told it in the city and in the country. Then people went out to see what had happened, and they came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had gone, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind; and they were afraid. And those who had seen it told them how he who had been possessed with demons was healed. Then all the people of the surrounding country of the Gadarenes asked Jesus to depart from them; for they were seized with great fear; so He got into the boat and returned. The man from whom the demons had gone begged that he might be with Jesus; but Jesus sent him away, saying, "Return to your home, and declare all that God has done for you." And he went away, proclaiming throughout the whole city all that Jesus had done for him.

في ذلكَ الزمانِ أتى يسوعُ إلى كورةِ الجرجسيينِ فاستقبلَهُ رَجُلٌ من المدينةِ بهِ شياطينُ مُنذُ زمانٍ طويلٍ ولمْ يَكُنْ يَلْبَسُ ثوباً ولا يَأوي إلى بيتِ بَلٍ إلى القبورِ * فلَمَّا رأى يسوعُ صاحَ وخرَّ لَهُ وقال بصوتٍ عظيمٍ ما لي ولكَ يا يسوعُ ابنُ اللهِ العليِّ. أطلُبُ إليكَ ألا تُعذِّبني * فإنه أمرَ الرُّوحِ النجسِ أن يخرُجَ من الإنسانِ لأنه كان قد اختطفَهُ مُنذُ زمانٍ طويلٍ وكان يربُطُ بسلاسلٍ ويحبسُ بقيدٍ فيقطعُ الرُّبُطَ ويساقُ من الشيطانِ إلى البراري * فسألهُ يسوعُ قائلاً ما اسمُكَ. فقال له لحيون لأنَّ شياطينَ كثيرينَ كانوا قد دخلوا فيه * وطلَبوا إليه أن لا يأمرَهُم بالذهابِ إلى الهاويةِ * وكان هُنَاكَ قطعُ خنازيرٍ كثيرةٍ ترعى في الجبلِ * فطلَبوا إليه أن يأذنَ لَهُم بالدخولِ فيها فأذنَ لَهُم * فخرَّجَ الشياطينَ من الإنسانِ ودخلوا في الخنازيرِ فوثبَ القطيعُ عن الجرفِ إلى البحيرةِ فاحتنقَ * فلَمَّا رأى الرعاةَ ما حدثَ هربوا فأخبزوا في المدينةِ وفي الحقولِ * فخرَّجوا ليرَوُا ما حدثَ وأتوا إلى يسوعَ فوجدوا الإنسانَ الذي خرَّجت منه الشياطينَ جالسا عندَ قدمي يسوعَ لابساً صحيحَ العقلِ فخافوا * وأخبرَهُم الناظرُونَ أيضاً كيف أبرأَ المجنونَ * فسألهُ جميعُ جمهورِ كورةِ الجرجسيينَ أن ينصرفَ عنهمُ لأنه اعتراهمُ خوفٌ عظيمٌ. فدَخَلَ السفينةَ ورجعَ * فسألهُ الرَّجُلُ الذي خرَّجت منه الشياطينَ أن يكونَ مَعَهُ. فصرَفَهُ يسوعُ قائلاً إرجعْ إلى بيتِكَ وحدثْ بما صنَعَ اللهُ إِلَيْكَ. فذهبَ وهو ينادي في المدينةِ كُلِّها بما صنَعَ إليه يسوعُ.

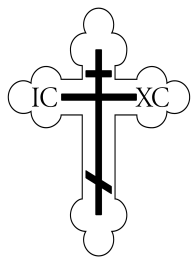
